MINUTES:

26.27/32 Apologies

Apologies were received from SB, NO, HS and KW.

26.27/33 Declarations of interest or requests for dispensation.

None.

26.27/34 Public Session

A The Chair of the Luxulyan Allotment Association attended and was able to answer questions from the members about their application.

The Allotment application (37.A.i) was brought forward. See the decision at that Item.

B A member of Luxulyan Environment Green Glebe Space (LEGGs) attended and was able to answer questions from the members about their application.

The LEGGS application (37.A.ii) was brought forward. See the decision at that Item.

Two members of the public left the meeting.

26.27/35 Meetings and governance

A The council **RESOLVED** (proposed DB, 2nd JC) that the minutes, as read, of the meeting held on 29 April 2026 are a true and correct record and they were duly signed.

26.27/36 Finance

A The Clerk reported that the £5000 expected from the Solar Farm has arrived. The current LPCF balance is £20,362.44.

B It was **RESOLVED** (proposed HF, 2nd JC) to approve payment of £10 per session for the room hire of the Institute for this and the previous meetings.

C It was **RESOLVED** (proposed DB, 2nd JC) that the Clerk is delegated to arrange the immediate payment of room hire from LPCF funds for any future meeting. It is noted that meetings are usually in the Luxulyan Memorial Institute or the Village Hall.

26.27/37 Applications

A Applications received.

- i. Allotments, Bridges, Luxulyan PL30 5EF. The Luxulyan Allotment Association requested a grant for the purchase of a rotovator, strimmer, storage shed and fencing for the chippings area. Their current strimmer is on its last legs. The members do not do any fund raising but do donate a parcel of land to Luxulyan School. The Committee emphasised the need for security for the new equipment. The Committee **RESOLVED** (proposed DB, 2nd HF) to support the application for £3,000.
- ii. LEGGS. Luxulyan PL30 5EA. Their shed is in very bad condition and the roof leaks as they found out this winter! LEGGS members are active and successful fund raisers. The Green Space is often used by Luxulyan School for projects and activities. The Committee **RESOLVED** (proposed NP, 2nd HF) to grant LEGGS £2,500 for a new shed.

B Reports on previous applications.

- i. Biscovey Youth Football Club (Minute 25.26/28.B) sent photos of the new girls' toilet block under construction and the Committee has heard it is now finished or almost finished and looks very good. The Club is very appreciative of LPCF's help.
