



# CSI Scorecard 2024

## Bokiddickstream




The overall score for the catchment is based on a year's data collected at all sites in the waterbody. It is calculated from the observations and water quality results obtained during a Westcountry Citizen Science Investigation (CSI) survey. A waterbody must have at least 12 samples taken over the year for it to qualify for a scorecard.

Please note – from 2022 a change to how the PO4 score is calculated has been implemented.



\*To avoid overestimation, the number of sampling locations is based on the relative proximity (15 m) of location coordinates.

The following information is summarised based on the number of surveys carried out in 2024.

#### Land Use

Land use within 50 m: Woodland (30), Grassland/pasture (30), Agriculture (9).

#### **Invasive Species**

Invasive plants: None observed (18), Other (12).

### Wildlife

Wildlife spotted: Dragonflies/Damselflies (3), Other (10), None (18).

#### Pollution

Pollution sources: None (21), Road runoff (9).Pollution evidence: None (26), Foam (3).
